Event date: May 8, 2010

Location: Dumbarton Middle School, Baltimore County

Applications received AFTER April 1, 2010, must be accompanied by a **\$35 late fee PER EVENT**. No applications will be accepted after April 13, 2010.

Note: Sixth Grade students who qualify for the State Festival through a District Festival may participate at the State level. (Not all Districts allow sixth grade students to participate.) No Grade One Music may be performed at the State Festival.

1. Only students who have earned a rating of "I" at the local District Festival may apply for the State Festival.
2. There are no substitutions. The person or persons who qualify at the District level must be the same persons who perform at the State Level.
3. PRINT, in black ink, or TYPE the information on the application. Make sure the information is correct and legible. Incomplete or illegible forms will not be accepted.
4. All Music performed must be listed on the MMEA web page (MMEA-MARYLAND.org) List the title of the piece exactly as it appears on the MMEA web page. Be sure to fill in the level of difficulty ("grade") of the selection and the composer's name. If the selection is from a collection, list the name of the collection and the number of the selection. Performance of music not on these two lists will not be allowed.
5. Copyright: MODA operates in compliance with U.S. Copyright laws. Anyone using a photo copy of the music will not receive a rating unless accompanied by written verification of permission from the publisher.
6. Complete the name and phone number of the accompanist. Give the Accompanist Form to accompanists if he or she is playing for three or more events.

Return this application to your school orchestra director in time for it to be signed by the director and school principal and sent before the deadline for receipt by April 1. Late applications will be accepted if accompanied by the **\$35 late fee PER EVENT**. Directors are responsible for the completeness and timelines of the applications. No applications will be accepted after April 13. Teachers, not students or parents, may call the MMEA Office with questions. The phone number is published in the MMEA Journal. Schedules and directions will be mailed to participating orchestra directors.
